







I Segnalati: 45 Artists at New York by Salvatore Russo

At one of the world's most prestigious art fairs, the exhibition "I Segnalati," curated by Salvatore Russo, will be hosted. This new edition of the art volume, limited to only 45 international artists, has been introduced in past years in Paris, Brussels, Edinburgh, Naples, Berlin, Rome, Lisbon, Venice, Budapest, and London. This year, it makes its debut in this distinguished state.



Each artist will be featured with a dedicated 2-page and 1/3page spread in the volume I Segnalati. The 2-page section will showcase two of their artworks, while the 1/3-page will include a biographical text, a personal photo, and a critique in English by Salvatore Russo. Alongside the publication, an art exhibition will take place from April 3 to 6, 2024, at the splendid New York art fair. Artists selected for the exhibition should choose works with maximum dimensions of 80x80 cm for paintings, and for sculptures, a maximum height of 40 cm and weight of 20 kg.



This year, Artexpo New York will host an exceptional selection of contemporary artworks, sculptures, photography, design, and new forms of artistic expression, offering each participant a unique opportunity to discover trends and innovations in the art world. Exhibitors will have the chance to showcase their works to an international audience of executives, architects, interior designers, curators, and corporate art buyers, thus ensuring visibility and high-level collaboration opportunities. In addition to the exhibitions, Artexpo New York will feature a series of side events, conferences, workshops, and panels with industry experts and prominent figures from the contemporary art scene, ideal for exploring current topics and future trends. Wi-



thin this framework, the project I Segnalati: 45 Artists at New York, curated by Salvatore Russo on behalf of the Fondazione Effetto Arte, will be introduced. With a prominent position in the international art scene and a tradition that attracts over 30,000 visitors each year, Artexpo New York 2025 is an unmissable event for anyone looking to immerse themselves in the world of contemporary art, forge new connections, and appreciate artistic talent from every corner of the globe.
